Your role will include offering pastoral care and welfare support to members of the church and the community; training and coordinating work of local volunteers and lay preachers; support the pastorate in providing for the spiritual and all-round needs of the congregation, empathise with members of the church and the community, coordinate Christian programmes; conduct religious programmes in accordance with Pentecostal traditions; lead the congregation in prayers; interpret doctrines, articles of faith in local (Nigerian) languages especially in Igbo.

As International Missions, Health and Wellbeing Coordinator, the successful candidate would be involved in organising annual Missions, Health and Wellbeing and conference across all our partner churches as well as our international congregations' Health and Wellbeing programmes. These also include the use of media platforms such as zoom and Facebook to mobilise Health and Wellbeing for special activities in the global churches.
